Javits Center Opens New Doors to Success

Business Issue

After migrating from an IBM VSE/CICS mainframe, the Jacob K. Javits Convention Center in New York City re-hosted its custom financial, booking, invoicing, human resources, order entry, purchasing, and advertising applications in a Micro Focus COBOL environment with CICS emulation support. The Javits Center required a solution that would upgrade its server and SQL database, provide solid, continuing support, offer a direct route to Windows graphical user interfaces, and protect the organization from the risk and cost of additional COBOL migrations in the future.

Solution

The Javits Center team chose Acucorp's ACUCOBOL-GT development suite to satisfy their business requirements, which included a critical upgrade to Microsoft Windows 2000 Server and Microsoft SQL Server 2000. The team considered Fujitsu COBOL, Micro Focus Net Express, and even a complete rewrite in Visual Basic, but concluded that none provided an easier or more flexible approach to preserving, modernizing and future-proofing the existing business logic than ACUCOBOL-GT. With this conversion, the Javits Center team has successfully upgraded its database, and is gradually transitioning from a character-based user interface to a Windows graphical interface.

The Javits Center's proprietary code was migrated to ACUCOBOL-GT by Acucorp Professional Services Partner, Unicon Conversion Technologies, Inc., whose conversion expertise and automated conversion tools have made the company an industry leader. Complex SQL queries in the existing code provided unique challenges, but the Acucorp support team was very responsive and provided tailored solutions.

Benefits

The migration to open systems improved application and reporting speed-reducing report time from hours to minutes. This allowed users to run their own reports, and eliminated the need for overnight technical shifts for reporting and backup. Now, as the Javits Center prepares for physical expansion, ACUCOBOL-GT has given its proprietary applications room to grow. According to Senior Vice President and CFO Ed MacDonald, "In addition to being significantly faster, the system now has the capacity to handle an expansion that could double the number of customers we serve." With Acucorp's extend® family of products, Javits Center technical personnel can now keep up with future Microsoft operating system and SQL releases, sparing them from future migrations. Equally important, the MIS staff at the Javits Center has found the responsiveness of Acucorp's technical support team to be invaluable.

Future Plans

The Javits Center plans to acquire surrounding West Side real estate in preparation for New York City's bid to host both a Summer Olympics and a professional football team.
